The Aquatic Center (AKA "Pool") is staffed by American Red Cross certified lifeguards and Water Safety Instructors and is open to all DoD ID card holders. Whether you are a trained swimmer or a beginner, our staff can help meet your aquatic related fitness needs. The Aquatic Center has two pools; the new Indoor Pool located within the Fitness Center building (opening in March) and the Outdoor Pool which is open in the summer months only. Water aerobic and open swim punch cards are a great way to save money on frequent visits.

Events & Programs

- Baby and Me Swim - Every Tuesday at 11 a.m. Parents and babies under the age of three can come to class for a small fee per session for the pair
- FREE Family Swim Day - First Sunday of each month
- FREE Teen Night - First Friday of each month
- Lap Swim - Any time the pool is open, a minimum of one lap lane is available with the exception of Novice Swim Team (FREE)
- Masters Swim Team - FREE year around team for adults of all swimming abilities
- Novice Swim Team (Aqua Aviators) - Swim team for kids under the age of 18 that focuses on stroke technique and endurance building at a monthly fee.
- Open Swim - FREE for youth five and under. There is a small fee for everyone else
- Pool Parties - Available on Saturday evenings from 6 - 8 p.m., call for reservations
- Private Lessons - One-on-one lessons for children and adults paid for a half an hour session at a time
- Water Aerobics - A low impact workout that offers something for everyone
- Youth Swim Lessons - Group lessons for youth ages three through 17. Lessons are held at the Indoor Pool unless the Outdoor Pool is open. Call for the schedule
