



Fairchild Inn & Survival Inn

There are two lodging facilities on base; Fairchild Inn and Survival Inn. Personnel on orders are encouraged to make reservations as soon as assignment notification is received. Personnel in Space Available (Space A) status may make reservations three to 120 days in advance of arrival, depending on occupancy

level. Room rates range from \$34.75 to \$53.25 per night depending upon the availability of room type at the time of reservation. Lodging check-in is 2 p.m. and check-out time is 11 a.m. All lodging rooms are non-smoking and guests are responsible for room damages. Government shuttle service is available on base for official government business only, call 247-2244. Fairchild Inn

The Fairchild Inn is on main base and is utilized by TDY, PCS and Space A guests. Lodging at Fairchild consists of 63 guest rooms and 42 Temporary Lodging Facilities (TLF), of which 17 are "pet friendly". There is a two pet limit for an assessed fee per night. Shot records must be presented at check-in and the pet must be kenneled (kennels provided) when left unattended in the room. Priority 1 TDY personnel will be provided on-base lodging and Priority 1 TDY personnel with family members will be considered "Space A" and assigned to lodging. If no space is available, they will not be provided "non-availability" to lodge off base. Call 247-5519 for details.

Survival Inn

The Survival Inn is a 220 room, 384 bed facility configured for single and double occupancy whose primary mission is to support USAF Survival School students. Students assigned to rooms configured for double occupancy will each pay the full room rate as provided for in AFI 34-246, para 4.6.3. Students arriving via Spokane International Airport are encouraged to make travel arrangements to Fairchild by any local cab company at their own cost. Survival students arriving from CONUS may arrive one day prior to class start date and OCONUS students may arrive two days prior to class start date. Call 247-5127 for further information.
