The Preteen and Teen Center are co-located in one building but separated into two individual programs. The program will relocate to the other side of the building in the old Arts & Crafts Center. Both centers have half-day camps available during summer, winter and spring breaks. Our affiliations with the Boys & Girls Clubs of America, 4H and Air Force programming provide activities that meet the developmental needs of youth. Preteen Center
