They can take you from a beginner all the way to receiving your own diploma in "Adult Woodworking". Classes are eight weeks long and are rated one of the best in the Department of Defense. Air Force regulations require all patrons to possess an Equipment Qualification Card in order to use equipment in the Wood Craft Center.

Woodworking I (Beginning); Jan. 4, Apr. 4, Jul. 11 & Oct. 3

You will build a night stand and learn drawer construction, joinery, planing, shaping, gluing and oil finishing. No prior experience is required. Class schedule will be determined on the first day and classes will be once a week from 6 - 9 p.m.

Woodworking II (Intermediate); Jan. 5, Apr. 5, Jul. 5 & Oct. 4

You will construct a raised panel dresser with dovetailed drawers to further your basic skills. Woodworking I is a prerequisite for this course. Class are Thursdays from 6 - 9 p.m.

Woodworking III (Advanced); Jan. 12, Apr. 12, Jul. 12 & Oct. 11

Choose your project from a selection (china cabinet, gun cabinet, desk or bed). This course, taken in sequence with Woodworking I & II, qualifies you for an Adult Woodshop Degree. Class are Thursdays from 6 - 9 p.m.

Woodworking IV (Advanced); Time arranged during normal business hours

For students who wish to further their knowledge after completion of Woodworking I, II and III. Fee based on a 30 day period.
