Date/Location:

Scholarship recipients must be able to attend the entire Space Camp program. Recipients arrive in Huntsville AL on Sunday, 22 Jul 12 and depart on Friday, 27 Jul 12. Overseas travelers may arrive on 21 Jul 12.

Travel Expenses:

Lodging, meals, and activity fees after arrival at Space Camp are centrally funded. **Airfare or POV travel costs to Huntsville, AL are the responsibility of the attendee or the installation.** Spending money for miscellaneous expenses is the responsibility of the participant.

Eligible Applicants:

The applicant must meet the following requirements:

- A dependent of Active Duty Military assigned to or living on an AF/JB installation, AF Retired Military, AF Civilian Employees, Air National Guard or AF Reserve who have been activated within the last 12 months
- Must have a minimum GPA of 2.8 (must provide documentation)
- Must be ages 12-14 to attend Space Academy, which is an intense experience designed to immerse middle school students in the science and technology of the space program.
- Must be ages 15-18 to attend Advanced Space Academy®. The Academy will immerse teens in science, technology, engineering and math while focusing on college and career preparation.

Please read carefully, nominations not completed properly will not be accepted.

1. Submit completed nomination forms (atch 1) to your Youth Programs Director, Guard or Reserve representative (if applicable), or designee to set up an interview.
2. After the interview process has been completed, Youth Programs staff or designee will forward nominations to their respective MAJCOM representatives who will upload to the HQ AFSVA/SVPY Share Point.
3. All completed applications must be received by 24 February 2012
