CCAF gives academic recognition for an airman’s military credits, management and additional general education courses and/or CLEP/DANTES exams. Over 150 CCAF degrees are awarded annually at Fairchild. The ***CCAF degree plan** is generally the initial plan for enlisted personnel when requesting AF Tuition Assistance.
